



Taking a child he placed it in their midst, and putting his arms around it he said to them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me."

- Mk 9:36-37

25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me." This statement from Jesus is actually very similar to the famous passage from Matthew's Gospel where he says, "Whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me" (25:40). But in Matthew, this idea of serving Jesus by serving others is applied to more dramatic cases: the hungry and thirsty, the sick and imprisoned, the naked and the stranger. Isn't it interesting to note that caring for children can also be a way of experiencing Christ's presence among us?

For many people, "receiving" a child is part of their daily routine. Those of us who are parents obviously welcome children into our families and continue to serve them throughout their lives. Grandparents, siblings, other relatives, foster parents, and sometimes neighbors and friends also make room in their homes and their hearts to welcome the children God has placed in their circle. Teachers, physicians, therapists, and others who work with children on a professional level are also in the "business" of receiving children. How wonderful to think that all of this normal activity can offer us the opportunity to encounter Christ!

Because dealing with children can become routine, or at times even be filled with challenges and frustrations, we might need to pause to remind ourselves about the blessings that they bring. Certainly their joy and innocence is a gift in itself, but in today's Gospel we are reminded that their presence brings more than that. When we serve children in a spirit of generosity, when we "receive" them as they are--with all that entails--we are in turn receiving Jesus ... who first came to us as a child.

Q. Why do we celebrate Catechetical Sunday?

A. The mission of the church reflects the mission of Jesus to teach, preach, heal, and forgive. Through these acts, Jesus shares the good news of salvation and invites all people to share in the life and love of God. The church continues this mission in all its ministries, but especially, and perhaps most importantly, through catechesis.

Catechetical Sunday is celebrated on the third Sunday of September. The task of handing on the Gospel is entrusted to the whole community, who by word and example, form young and new members in the way of the Gospel. Parish programs assist parents in teaching the basics of faith through liturgical experience, instruction, and faith formation. This ministry is essential for the parish to grow, for individuals to develop as believers, and for the ongoing spiritual formation of the whole community. It reminds the church that preaching the Gospel and growing in faith are essential to our sacramental practice and our liturgical prayer. On this Sunday, we recognize those who are called to be teachers and ask for God's blessing and grace.

PARISH CENSUS

In an effort to ensure that the Parishioner Database is current and to ensure inclusion of each person listed in the Parishioner Database, the following efforts were made:

On 5/22/15 a census form/instruction letter was mailed to all 1730 families

On 7/7/15 post card reminders were mailed to the 876 non-respondents

Weekly reminders to complete/return census forms were published in the parish bulletin

Reminder posters were prominently positioned in the foyers of both churches

Monthly pulpit announcements encouraged all to complete/return census forms

A Census Booth was set up at the Parish Summer Festival

Census forms were made available in the foyers of both churches as well as at the parish office

As of September 21, 60% of the census forms were returned. The final stage to solicit parishioners' information by personal telephone calls to more than 725 delinquent respondents is continuing. Disconnected telephones/answering machines/no answers account for 135 of calls made thus far. Those who are unreachable/unwilling to return phone calls/unwilling to verify data/submit completed form/etc. – whose attendance at Mass can be verified will be marked unresponsive; those whose attendance at Mass CANNOT be verified will be removed.

To those parishioners who have not responded, please return your forms no later than October 1.
