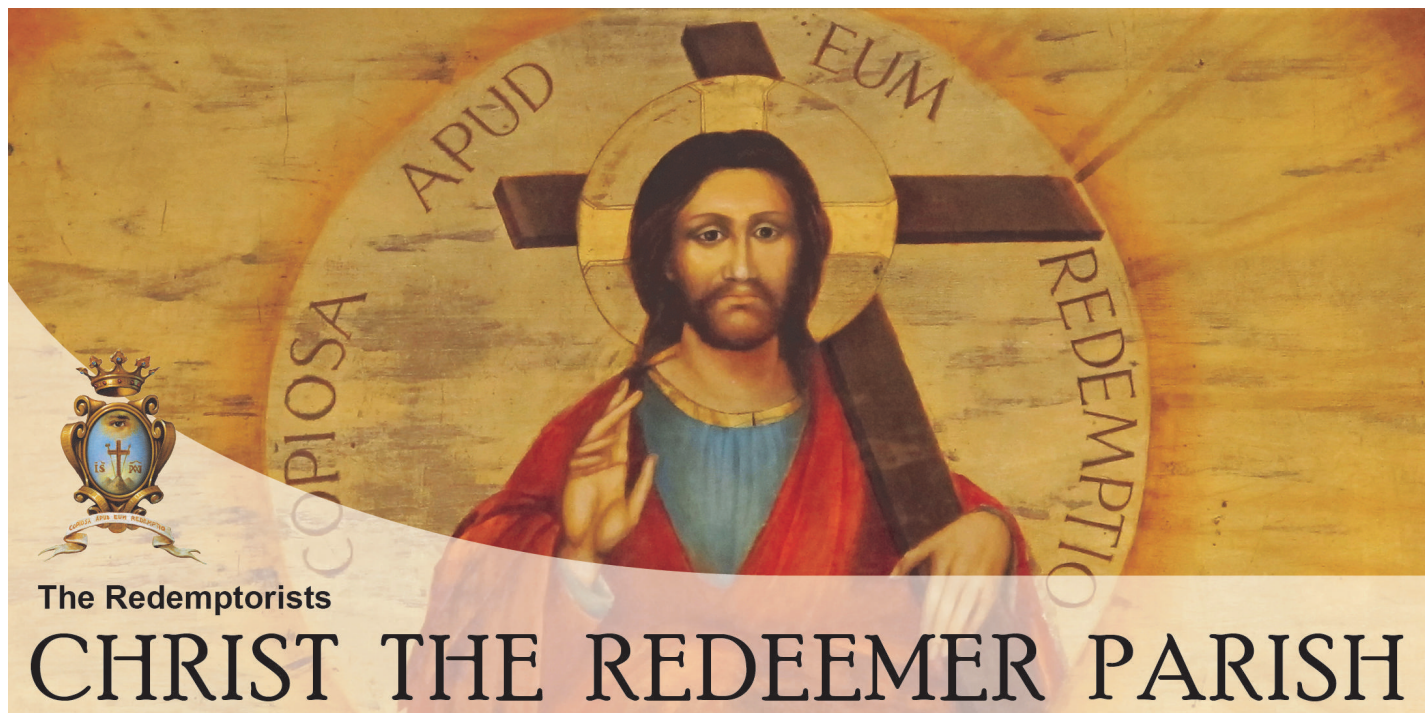

Jesus said to them, "Come, have breakfast." And none of the disciples dared to ask him, "Who are you?" because they realized it was the Lord. Jesus came over and took the bread and gave it to them, and in like manner the fish.

- Jn 21:12-13

3rd Sunday of Easter

"Jesus said to him the third time, 'Simon, son of John, do you love me?'" Three times, Simon Peter had denied Jesus. Now, three times, the risen Christ gives Peter the opportunity to announce his love. Although Peter was "distressed" by the Lord's repeated question, ultimately this must have been a healing moment in Peter's life. He finally had the opportunity to assure Jesus that he loved him, thereby making up for his earlier failure and weakness on the night of the Crucifixion.

Jesus' death on the cross sufficed to forgive us of our sins. But his resurrection assures us that there is new life on the other side of our sinfulness. Just as Jesus had the power to conquer death, so too through his grace we have the power to conquer our sins. We can live a resurrected life, we can have a new beginning, just as Peter did that day at the Sea of Tiberias when he pledged his faith anew.

This pledge of faith, it's interesting to note, also came with a kind of commission. Each time that Peter told the Lord he loved him, Jesus responded with a command: "Feed my lambs," "Tend my sheep," and "Feed my sheep." Of course, we know that Jesus had already established Peter as the "rock" on which he built his church, as the first pope. Now, Jesus was emphasizing the connection between loving him--the Good Shepherd--and loving his people, his flock, his church. Peter's love for Christ was meant to be manifested in his love and care for the church, as is the case with every pope. But it's also true for every Christian. We are called not just to relish the gift of forgiveness and the grace of new life in Christ, but to take the next step of loving and serving those around us.

How to behave in a church?

A church is a place of worship, where people come to pray, meet Christ and build community around Him. We remind you of some rules that bind us in the house of God which respect and show reverence to these sacred places in our parish.

Please come to the liturgy punctually. Closed bridges, detours, etc. can surprise you only the first time. Future lateness is caused mostly by laziness.

Turn off your cell phone. Always! And don't answer any calls. Your family and friends can wait for you. Holy Mass is more important – twenty years ago no one could call you during the liturgy and everything was OK.

Please do not talk before the liturgy. You disturb others. Rather think about the liturgy and try to open your heart to peace and silence. We can hear God's voice only in silence.

If you have to leave for a short time for any reason, please, re-enter at the appropriate time and try not to disturb others.

Don't leave until a final hymn concludes.

As you leave after the liturgy don't talk in the church. You disturb those who stay for prayer and adoration.

Please, do not chew any gum in the church. An appropriate place for dental hygiene is at your home. And please don't stick chewed gum under pews!

A church isn't a beach or a gym. Please dress appropriately to the solemnity of the place. Teach children to do the same.

If your child cries for a very long time and you can't stop him or her, you can always use our cry room.

Wyłącz telefon komórkowy. Zawsze! I nie odbieraj jakichkolwiek rozmów. Twoja rodzina i przyjaciele mogą poczekać na Ciebie, Msza św. jest ważniejsza – 20 lat temu nikt nie mógł się dodzwonić do Ciebie w czasie liturgii i wszystko było dobrze.

Nie rozmawiaj przed Mszą św. Przeszkadzasz innym. Pomyśl raczej o liturgii i spróbuj otworzyć swe serce na pokój i ciszę. Boga można usłyszeć jedynie w ciszy.

Jeśli musisz na krótko wyjść, to wracając uczyni to odpowiednim czasie i nie przeszkadzaj pozostałym.

Nie wychodź zanim nie skończy się pieśń na zakończenie.

Opuszczając kościół nie rozmawiaj. Przeszkadzasz tym, którzy zostają na modlitwę dziękczynienia i adoracji.

We have pre-packaged boxes available for "walk-in" assistance. Only easy open/non-perishable items should be donated. Fresh foods or baked goods do not have an extended shelf-life and usually wind up being discarded. We could use tuna and mayonnaise, peanut butter and jelly, fruit, tomato sauce and pasta, juice, cereal without sugar. Try to make your donation into a complete meal.
